- 1 City Hall and Nathan Phillips Square—Free tours daily. QUEEN cars or BAY buses to Queen & Bay.
- 2 BUS TERMINAL, Gray Coach, Greyhound, Voyageur, GO Buses and The Gray Line. SUBWAY to Dundas St. and walk 1 block west to Bay St. DUNDAS cars or BAY buses to Bay and Dundas.
- 3 Art Gallery of Ontario—DUNDAS cars to Beverley Street.
- 4 Campbell House—1822, restored in 1972, home of Chief Justice Wm. Campbell. SUBWAY to Ossonge St. QUEEN cars to University.
- 5 Royal Alexandra Theatre—SUBWAY to St. Andrew St. and walk west 1 1/2 blocks, or KING cars to Simcoe Street.
- 6 Toronto Stock Exchange—BAY buses or KING cars to Bay and King.
- 7 Union Station—N. M., O. P. and GO Trains. SUBWAY to Union Station or BAY buses to Front St.
- 8 Ferry Docks For Toronto Islands—SUBWAY to Union Station and transfer to BAY buses to Ferry Docks.
- 9 Keele Centre and St. Lawrence Centre for the Arts. SUBWAY to King Station and walk south on Yonge St. to Front St.
- 10 St. Lawrence Hall—1850—restored in 1967. KING cars to Jarvis St.
- 11 Mackenzie House, 82 Bond Street, historical museum. Home of Sir William Lyon Mackenzie. DUNDAS cars to Church St. and walk 1 block west.
- 12 Allan Gardens—botanical garden and park. CARLTON cars to Spadina Ave. and walk east 1 block.
- 13 Maple Leaf Gardens—home of the Toronto Maple Leaf and Toronto Toros Hockey Clubs. CARLTON cars to Church St. — SUBWAY to College St. and walk east 1 block.
- 14 Ontario Place, the province's showcase, open May 18 to Oct. 14. BATHURST cars or DUFFERIN buses to Exhibition.
- 15 Exhibition Park—Marine Museum, Hockey Hall of Fame, the Canadian National Exhibition Aug. 14 to Sept. 2. BATHURST cars or DUFFERIN buses to park gates.
- 16 Fort York—historical museum. BATHURST cars to gate on Fleet St.

PLACES OF INTEREST IN "THE PEOPLE CITY"

- 17 Markham Village—quaint centre for artists. SUBWAY to Bathurst St. (Markham Street Exit).
- 18 Varsity Stadium — home of Toronto Metros Soccer Club. SUBWAY to St. George St. (Bedford Exit).
- 19 Royal Ontario Museum and McLaughlin Planetarium. SUBWAY to Museum St. AVENUE RD. buses stop at the doors.
- 20 Parliament Buildings—seat of the Ontario Government. WELLESLEY buses to Queen's Pk.
- 21 Yorkville Village—SUBWAY to Bay St. (Cumberland Exit). AVENUE RD. or BAY buses to Yorkville.
- 22 High Park—300 acres of natural playground, including small zoo, flower gardens and Grenadier Pond. SUBWAY to High Pk. QUEEN cars to Howard Rd. or CARLTON cars right into the park.
- 23 Casa Loma—Toronto's fabulous castle completed in 1914. Open daily. SPADINA buses to Davenport Rd.
- 24 Tomcordeon Mills—historical museum in park setting. May 1st to Oct. 31st. Open daily except Monday. BROADVIEW OR MORTIMER buses to Pottery Rd. Walk down hill.
- 25 Ontario Science Centre—where young and old can experience the world of science. Open daily. EGLINTON EAST buses to Don Mills Rd. or DON MILLS buses to St. Dennis Dr.
- 26 Greenwood Race Track—thoroughbred and harness racing. QUEEN cars or COXWELL buses to Queen & Kingston Rd. WOODBINE SOUTH buses to Queen & Woodbine.
