



If you have to take more than one bus, streetcar, subway or RT train, you can get a free paper transfer where and when you nay your fare. Keep this transfer if you're transferring from or vehicle to another. Ask for a transfer from a driver or get one from the automatic transfer machine in the subway/RT station after you pay your fare. If you're transferring, do it right away. For example, you can't get off the TTC, do some shopping and then use the transfer again.






